

Widening and Reconstruction of Bathurst Street From Shallmar Boulevard to Lawrence Avenue

Public Open House

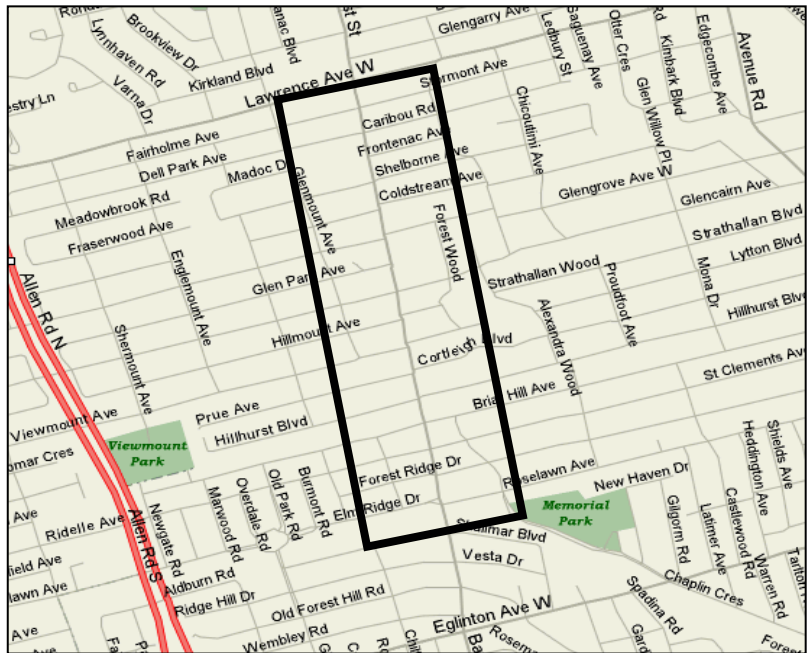
Beginning in early April 2007 and continuing to late November 2007, the City of Toronto, North York District will be undertaking widening and reconstruction of Bathurst Street from Shallmar Boulevard to Lawrence Avenue (**see map below**). The purpose of the work is to reduce future maintenance costs, prolong the service life of the road and enhance driver and pedestrian safety.

Design Details

The following work will be carried out as part of this project:

- Remove and replace pavement structure, curbs, sidewalks, etc on both sides of roadway;
- Remove and replace street parking and install new parking meters at designated areas;
- Update existing substandard water services within the road way;
- Plant new trees where space is available.

The project team will be present to explain the traffic management plan, construction staging, and answer any questions you may have about the project.
